The Hendon Brook 13.5 miles road race was started in 1984 as a fund raiser for the special school of the same name. At that time Hendon Brook Special School catered for children with physical handicaps but before 1970 it was known as the "Open Air" School and took children who were delicate and sick. In 1988 Hendon Brook was amalgamated with Brunlea School in Burnley and the new establishment of Primrose Hill School was formed on the Burnley site. The race has continued to be run from the old school of Hendon Brook which is now a Unit for emotionally disturbed young children. The Hendon Brook race is still one of the main fund raising activities for Primrose Hill School.
