The 21st Hendon Brook Half Marathon was totally dominated by Robin Whitley a former Colne man who now lives in Sydney, Australia. Robin, who competed regularly in Grand Prix years while he went to school and University, returned for a family holiday and took the opportunity of entering the tough Hendon Brook race. Although for the first five miles Thomas Cornthwaite, the reigning Grand Prix Champion, matched Robin step by step, the very steep climb out of Thursden Valley took their toll on Thomas and Robin was left out in front for the remaining 8 miles. Robin took the tape in an excellent time of 1.18.55 some 6 minutes ahead of Thomas who decided to jog the remaining miles. Peter Entwistle, Halifax, finished very strongly in 3rd place over one minute behind Thomas.

In the ladies race Clayton's Tracey Mitchell continued her fine form with another victory finishing over 4 minutes ahead of her club mate, Dany Robson. Alison Smith, also of Clayton, finished third and was also the first lady vet (LV35).

Former Hendon Brook winner, David Gregory was the first male vet (V40) coming in 4th overall. David Naughton (V45), Mark Nestor (V50), Ted Orrell (V65) and Aeron Rees (V70) were the other leading vets.

Ted Orrell failed to break his own V65 record by only 5 seconds. However in the lady vet category Jennifer Adams took 8mins 13 secs. off the previous time to see the only record broken on the day finishing in 5th position overall.
